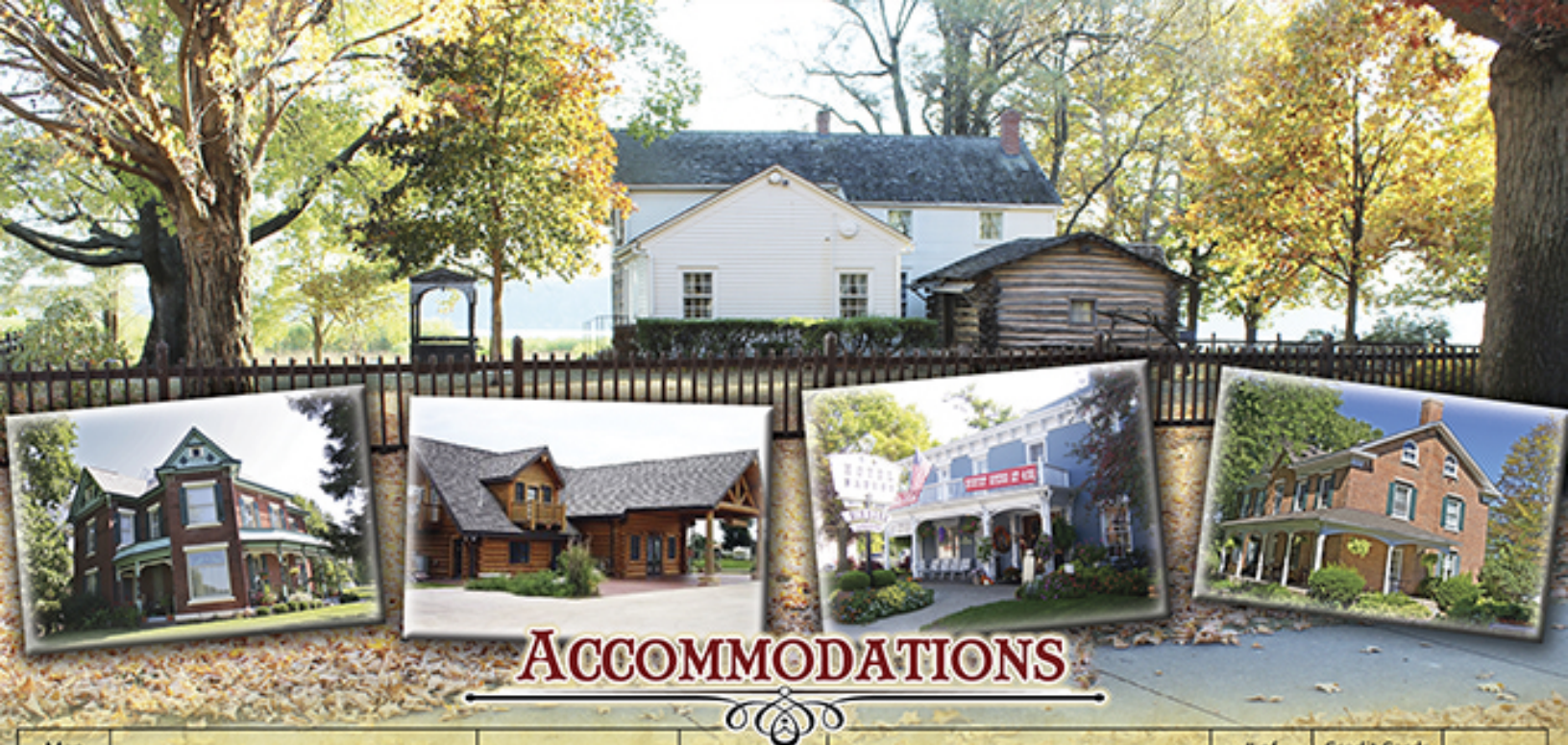

EVENTS & SHOWS

Winter

Bald Eagle Watching (Month of January)

As bald eagles flock to the Mississippi, enjoy watching them along the Great River Road near Nauvoo and participate in related events in surrounding communities

Untold Nauvoo Stories (First full weekend in February)

This historical symposium celebrates the people and events that make the Nauvoo area unique and significant in American History

Nauvoo Mormon Exodus Re-enactment (First full weekend in February)

The largest human migration in American history began at the end of Parley Street in Nauvoo, IL, in 1846. This re-enactment of the mormon exodus includes speakers, breakfast and a commemorative walk down Parley Street to the river's edge

Summer

Sunset by the Mississippi (Memorial Day - Labor Day)

A one-hour family friendly musical variety show, performed on an outdoor stage while the sun sets on the Mississippi River

The Promise (Memorial Day - Labor Day)

A popular one-hour musical play tells the story of life in the early 1840's, as immigrants came up the Mississippi River to Nauvoo

Just Plain Anna-Amanda (Memorial Day - Labor Day)

A delightful musical play about a young girl's discovery of what it means to be important; fun for the whole family

iDig Nauvoo (End of May - June)

A professional archaeological dig sponsored by the Joseph Smith Historical Site, volunteers accepted

BYU Performing Groups (June & Early August)

Award-winning ensembles from Brigham Young University perform evening shows for two weeks at a time, scheduled for 2016 are *International Folk Dance Ensemble*, *Noteworthy* and *Vocal Point*

Nauvoo Pageant & Frontier Country Fair (July/August)

A cast of more than 150 tells the story of Nauvoo, how it came to be and what it meant to those who lived here in the 1840's; before the show, enjoy 1840's style games and activities on the field adjoining the pageant site

Historical Vignettes (July/August)

Vignettes are performed in various locations throughout Historic Nauvoo to give guests an intimate look at events related to Nauvoo

Martyrdom Memorial (June 27th)

Events to commemorate the lives of Hyrum and Joseph Smith, Mormon leaders who were killed in 1844

Fall

Grape Festival (Labor Day Weekend)

Music, Food, Car Show, Crafts and Parades as the City of Nauvoo celebrates the fall harvest

Festival on Wheels Car Show (Labor Day Weekend)

Largest open air car show in the region, with more than 500 entries for your viewing pleasure

Great River Road Run (Second Saturday in October)

Charity half marathon, 5K, 10K run/walk or a 13.1 mile or the option of a 13.1 or 5 mile bike ride along one of the most scenic routes in the country!

Booiful Nauvoo (Saturday before Halloween)

Halloween fun featuring a haunted house and a parade on streets lined with hundreds of hand-carved Jack-O-Lanterns
