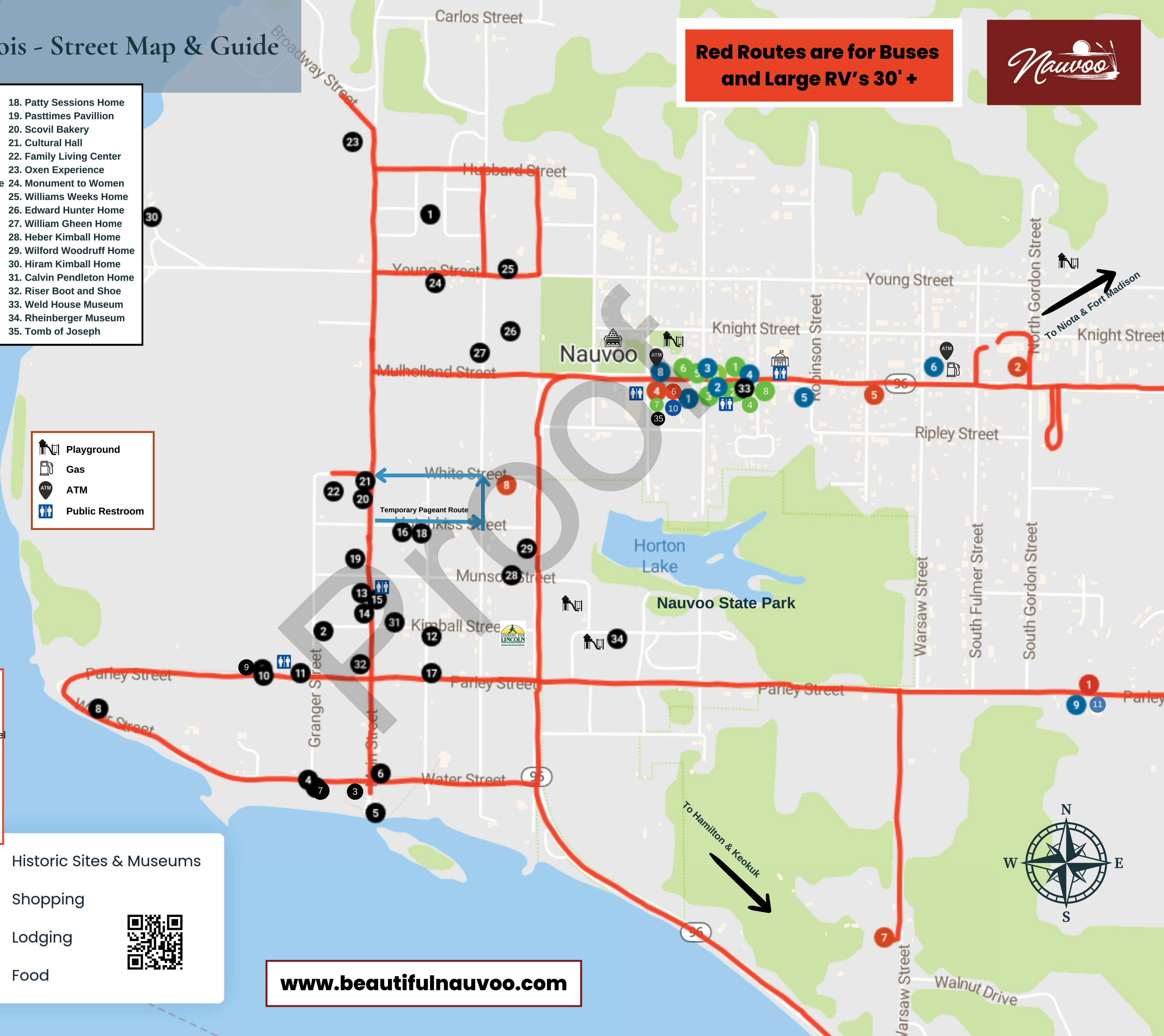

Serving Nauvoo dinner for 150 years! Featuring an award winning buffet.

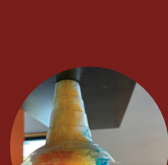

Explore historic Nauvoo with the annual Christmas walk. Horse drawn caroling rides, Christmas stories, and hot chocolate.

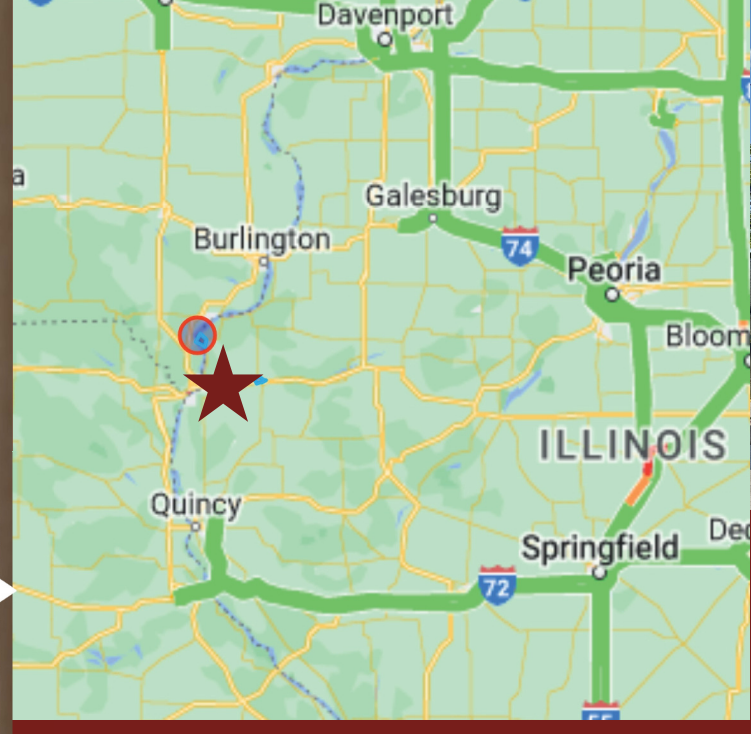
